

# **Climate justice**

# To preserve Creation itself.

Climate justice is at the heart of Lent in 2021. The countries of the global south are already severely impacted by the climate crisis. For the Swiss Catholic Lenten Fund (Fastenopfer), it is now a question of justice that those countries - including Switzerland – most responsible for greenhouse gases must also take the greatest responsibility for the repercussions. To respond to the climate crisis and to preserve Creation itself, we must find ways of living that are less materialistic. We must limit the global temperature rise to 1.5°C. Climate justice requires the will and desire to consume "less" and in place of this to foster "more" solidarity with the people that are suffering the effects. As individuals we can also make a vital contribution, for example by cutting back on meat and by flying less. This campaign seeks to grapple with the consequences of our behaviour and highlight the costs of overconsumption. However, it is about more than individual behaviour - it is also the primary task of business and politics.

Rice with cabbage and corn is simmering gently on an open fire. The effect is equally mouth-watering and eye-watering. As well as heating the food, the fire is causing the hut to fill with acrid smoke. "It's the only way to cook that I am able to afford," says Mariam from Kenya.

## Big and small


